- An event or activity designed to be of benefit to the community;
- An event or activity to support a *not-for-profit agency, institution or foundation that conforms to the ethical and religious standards of the Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board and the Ministry of Education;
- Any structured program that promotes tutoring, mentoring, visiting or coaching, or whose purpose is to assist others who require the benefit of that assistance;
- Participation in an event or activity that promotes positive environmental awareness;
- Participation in an event or activity that promotes positive inclusivity of all persons and contributes to the health and well-being of all members of the community, including school-based activities;
- Participation in an event or activity affiliated with a club, religious organization, arts or cultural
 association, or political organization that is inclusive of our Catholic values and makes positive
 contribution to the community.

NDSS has the discretion to approve or reject any activity or event that does not conform to the guiding principles and ethical standards for approved areas of involvement for students. Areas of involvement may include:

Ineligible Activities include, but not limited to:

- Involves operation of power tools, scaffolding, or vehicle)
- Involves "designated substances" under the Occupational Health and Safety Act
- Involves administration of any type or form of medication procedure o Regulated trades work
- Court-appointed work
- Work for commercial business
- Consists of personal recreation
- Duplication for credit in other courses
- During school hours (except lunch break or spare periods)
- Class or course requirements
- Provide direct financial benefit or gain to the students or to the student's immediate family
- Work that does not comply with or contradict Catholic teachings or the policies of the DPCDSB or Ministry of Education
